## Shop-Made Router Guides

Each router guide consists of two parts: a ${ }^{1 / 4 "}$ hardboard base that serves as a plafform for the router and $a^{3} / 4$ "-hick wood fence that guides the base of the router (see Illustration below).

To make the guide, you simply glue the fence to an extra-wide base ( $6^{\prime \prime}$ in my case) and then trim the base to width (Fig. 1).

There are two things to note here. First, use the same router and bit you'll use to cut the dadoes. And second, make a mark on the router and keep that mark in contact with the fence as you trim the base. The router will be oriented in the same way - with the mark against the fence when culting dadoes.
